Grounds	Comments
Columbarium/ Memorial Garden suggested at every round table meeting—include within the garden spaces to sit, pray, and reflect	The vestry is proceeding with plans for a memorial garden; an architect will be asked very shortly for his recommendations on siting, and design.
Develop a plan for additional parking spaces for future growth	Additional temporary parking spaces are available. Vestry is looking at ways to increase permanent spaces without interfering with other potential land uses.
Put a cross on the grounds or on the roof	We are split on this. While it may cause an architectural conflict to place one on the building, it is possible that one would be a part of a memorial garden. More on this later.
Add ornamental trees and bushes to landscape—start at the road with our sign and landscape should “direct the eye” toward the doorway	Will be evaluated again in the future, but is a low priority with current economic conditions.
Welcome sign for visitor parking more visible	Has been done.
Covered patio outside fellowship hall	A possibility, but not top priority.
Get rid of lirioppe (or not)	We have dissension, even on the vestry. Some say yea, some nay. Someone seems to have mowed it anyway.
